




# **Diploma in Addiction Counselling – Level**

The Diploma in Addiction Counselling Level 6 is a Competency-Based TVET program offered at Talent Eve Training Institute (TETI).

- Certificate in Counselling or Addiction Studies (Level 5), OR

- Physical Classes (on-campus)
- Virtual Learning (online mode)

#### Course Duration

- Maximum 2 academic years
- 6 semesters
